#### What job could training lead to?

After completing this qualification, you will be able to work as a health and safety practitioner, responsible for the organisation of safety and health functions within a workplace.

#### Am I eligible?

Open to any persons with a Year 10 level of education.

#### What will I receive?

Participants will receive a Certificate IV in Occupational Health and Safety (BSB41407).

#### Can I go on to further training?

Strong literacy and numeracy skills are required to undertake components of this course and complete assessments. The course requires students to read and comprehend materials from notes, standards and legislative material.
