Have sufficient physical strength and dexterity to do safety checks and basic maintenance, set up and dismantle the EWP and operate the EWP as required. If you believe you need assistance to complete these tasks, it is suggested that you speak to our staff who will arrange an interview for you with one of our Learning Support Teaching staff prior to commencing your study program. We can design a literacy and numeracy support program that meets your individual needs and course demands.
