#### What job could training lead to?

Completion of this short course will give the participant the opportunity to supervise, manage and implement OH&S strategies, programs and processes for surface coal & metalliferous mining industries.

#### Am I eligible?

Relevant to workers in the mining industry, who wish to supervise or represent workers on a mine site.

#### What will I receive?

Participants who demonstrate competency by passing both the theory and practical assessments will receive a Statement of Attainment in partial completion of RIIRIS402A Certificate IV in Surface Extraction Operations

#### Can I go on to further training?

Successful completion of this short course covers units from the national training package and may allow the participant recognition of studies towards Certificate IV/ Diploma in Surface Mining Operations. Depending on your desired outcomes, OHSA Mining Services offers a wide range of training pathways that may suit you.

#### Literacy, Numeracy and Assessment

Students must possess reasonable literacy and numeracy skills with a sound grasp of spoken English. It is recommended that students complete the Site Safety Supervisor course (S123) prior to undertaking this program: Participants will need sufficient physical ability to attend a one-day (10 hr) classroom based course.
