What job could training lead to?

This qualification is required for registration as a Rehabilitation and Return to Work Coordinator in Queensland as specified.

Am I eligible?

Nil pre-requisites, however all pre-reading activities will be sent to students upon enrolment.

What will I receive?

Participants who demonstrate competency by passing both the theory and practical assessments during the course will receive a Statement of Attainment from OHS&S. Confirmation of attendance and successful completion will then need to be submitted into Q-Comp for registration.

Can I go on to further training?

Further studies required to obtain Certificate IV. OH&S. Depending on your desired outcomes, OHS&S Training can offer a wide range of training pathways that may suit you, including Rehabilitation & RTW Coordinator and National Construction Inductions.

Literacy, Numeracy and Assessment

There are no restrictions on entry to this course however participants are required to be able to tolerate the physical demands of a two day classroom based course and have sufficient numeracy and literacy skills to read and comprehend OH&S literature. If you believe you need assistance to complete these tasks, it is suggested that you speak to our staff who will arrange an interview for you with one of our Learning Support Teaching staff prior to commencing your study program. We can design a literacy and numeracy support program that meets your individual needs and course demands.
