What job could training lead to?

Work as a Workplace Health & Safety Representative (WHSR's) or a members of a Health and Safety Committee

Am I eligible?

What will I receive?

Participants who demonstrate competency by passing both the theory and practical assessments will receive a Statement of Attainment for the 'Course in Functioning as a Workplace Health & Safety Representative: 30630QLD'.

Can I go on to further training?

Further studies are required to obtain Certificate IV, OH&S. Depending on your desired outcomes, OHS Training can offer a wide range of training pathways that may suit you, including WHSO, OH&S Consultant.

Literacy, Numeracy and Assessment

There are no restrictions on entry to this course however participants are required to be able to tolerate the physical demands of a three day classroom based course and have sufficient numeracy and literacy skills to read and comprehend OH&S literature. If you believe you need assistance to complete these tasks, it is suggested that you speak to our staff who will arrange an interview for you with one of our Learning Support Teaching staff prior to commencing your study program.
