#### Literacy, Numeracy and Assessment

There are no restrictions on entry to this course however participants are required to be able to tolerate the physical demands of a one day classroom based course. Basic literacy and numeracy skills are required to undertake components of this course and complete assessments. The course requires students to read and comprehend materials from notes, standards and legislative material. The assessment will require students to complete oral and written questions. If you believe you may need assistance to complete these tasks, it is suggested that you speak to our staff who will arrange for an interview for you with one of our Learning Support Teaching staff prior to commencing your study program. We can design a literacy and numeracy support program that meets your individual needs and course demands.
